

# UMD INTERNATIONAL STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

## DESCRIPTION AND ELIGIBILITY

The University of Minnesota Duluth (UMD) is committed to creating a diverse academic community and is pleased to invite qualified undergraduate international students to apply for the International Student Scholarship. The scholarship is valued at up to \$6,000 for 2019-2020, and awarded on a competitive basis to students who:

- Have an academic record of excellence
- Have demonstrated leadership and the potential to actively participate in the UMD community
- Are a newly admitted degree-seeking international undergraduate student who is on a non-immigrant temporary visa

The scholarship is renewed annually, contingent upon maintenance of 3.0 cumulative University of Minnesota (U of M) GPA, completion of 30 credits annually (can include summer), full-time undergraduate status, and maintenance of legal status.

## SUBMISSION CRITERIA

Students who wish to be considered for the scholarship must:

- Be admitted to UMD for Fall 2019 as a full-time degree-seeking undergraduate student on a non-immigrant temporary visa
